easy as it may sound. The actives had to clear everything out of the bedrooms and hallways, store it in the basement, and then move it all back in.

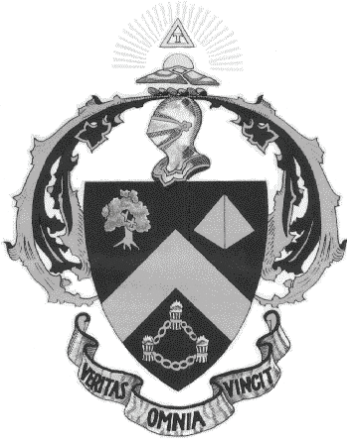
